Technology Tips and Requirements for ZOOM ART CLASSES

All students will need space, supplies, and adjustable lighting: An art table (that can get dirty) and a place to organize your supplies. You may want to cover the table to protect it. You need a lamp that can be moved around to the desired position. You need easel if you are working on canvas.

Technology requirements: You **must have your camera on** to participate.

Please do a test video feed with your Zoom camera (computer, iPad or phone) prior to class, to check whether your artwork will be seen by the teacher. This is important so I can give feedback. In your test, try different things. You may need to raise lighting on you & our artwork and lower lighting behind you, so you do not show up as a silhouette. TECH TIP: Here are some links on how to **use your phone as a webcam,** so I can see your artwork. Name your phone "XXXX'S Cam" and choose cancel to the audio option as you only want your voice on one device. The video explains how to do it pretty well (but you might want something more stable than soup cans:) More info in additional links.
